THE HISTORY OF CHRISTCHURCH UNITED



We won the Chatham Cup in 1972 in what is still considered one of the greatest Chatham Cup finals of all time, taking three matches to decide the winner.

The spectacular first leg in Wellington finished 4-4 draw with Graham Dacombe scoring all four goals, followed by a more conservative 1-1 draw at English Park. Conley's men finally claimed the trophy in a 2-1 win at Newmarket Park in Auckland.

The scenes of jubilation on the field and on return to Christchurch Airport were unrivalled, with 2000 fans welcoming home captain Ken France and his boys.

The victory was the first Chatham Cup win for a Canterbury team since Western won the trophy in 1955, so it had been a long time between drinks for Christchurch football fans.

The trophy put the infant club on the map and made a statement that Christchurch United was not there to make up numbers, but was focuses on filling the trophy cabinet.


