# WELCOME TO THIS WEEKEND'S DOUBLE-HEADER! WITH BOTH SHEPHERDS & MCFETRIDGE PARK HOSTING A MOMENTOUS COUPLE OF GAMES.

The first (Friday night) game is the last game to be played here at Shepherds on field 1, before the fields go over to begin final preparations for FIFA and the arrival of the Italian Women's Team. The second game is (again) at McFetridge Park, because we no longer have access to Shepherds.

The NRF Women's Conference team kick things off this weekend with a Friday night game, only possible due to the new Lighting (and field) upgrades that the Women's World cup has enabled. It is a nod to the possibilities before us as we work our way through the fixture list towards the end of this season and the new seasons ahead next year & beyond.

The Women's Conference team currently sit at the top of the Conference table, but Metro (who we are facing tonight) are only a point behind with a game in hand. So, our team's destiny is most firmly within their own hands. It has been great to witness the inclusion of the U16s into this group now competing in Women's football & a great debt of gratitude for all the mahi going into the Female Football Pathway, led by Janine Manga & the Female Football committee.

The Men's Premier team play Auckland City on Saturday at McFetridge Park, in the continuation of the Northern League, having last weekend confirmed their continuation in the Chatham Cup, with a fight of a fixture, needing extra time to get past a well organised Franklin team. Sitting just outside the top four, 6-points in arears but with a game in hand, like the Women's Conference team, the Men's Premier side have destiny firmly within their own hands. A win 3-weeks ago over Manurewa, starts the ascent to a place in the top four, with the game today against perennial champions City a tough ask, but with games against Auckland United & Eastern Suburbs still to come, we can afford some sense of optimism.

The Club upgrade project has experienced another massive week. Most of the construction fencing has gone to soon be replaced by the FIFA event fencing. The clubrooms officially get transferred to FIFA on Thursday 6th of July, and Italy are expected on site for their first training session on the Friday. So we have a very brief period of 11-days after today's game to complete final preparations, with some painting & cleaning projects on the existing parts of the Club to make sure it is properly prepared and presented for when Italy arrive.

It is appropriate at this time, to recognise some of the tireless mahi that has gone into the last two- and a-bit years of this project. I take this time now to humbly thank the following for all the time, thoughts & efforts of the past months, it has been gracious, constant and often immediately unrewarding. But ultimately this is a project that has set up our community for many generations to come. Thank you; William Taylor, Keith Lesslie, Neil Coventry, Simon Marsden, Stu Weir, Jebbie Warren, Ross Frisby, Sian Chad, Rochelle Lee, Melissa Sullivan, Hamish Young & Gareth Williams for everything you have given.




